

Next Sunday, **Vocation Sunday**, there will be a collection for **The Priests' Training Fund** to help the diocese pay the fees for our students in seminary.

**WALSINGHAM PILGRIMAGE:** The Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham is on **Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> May**. The programme for the day is as follows: from 1030-1215 there will be Eucharistic adoration in the Parish Church of the Annunciation in Friday Market. During this time it will be possible to celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation. At 1230 Bishop Alan will crown the Slipper Chapel statue and there will be a procession from Friday Market to the National Shrine of Our Lady. After arriving at the Shrine priests will be available at the 1948 crosses for the sacrament of reconciliation. The pilgrimage will conclude with Mass at 1500. If you would like to go, please make your own way there.
